Happy Friday to all our Cheadle Heath Primary School parents and carers! To ensure safety on the school grounds, we kindly ask that children and adults dismount from bikes and scooters at the school gate and not ride them in the playground.

Healthy Eating Policy

As a school we aim to work in partnership with parents in endeavouring to cultivate healthy eating habits for all our children. We will work with all partner agencies to adopt a sensible approach to all matters relating to healthy eating. We would be very grateful to have your support in following the standards we have adopted.

Morning Play snack: Fresh Fruit or Vegetables may be brought from home. Reception and KS1 will be provided with free fruit via the National Fruit Scheme.

Safeguarding Reminder

We work hard to ensure your child's safety remains paramount. We will only release your child to the adults that you have informed us are authorised to collect your child. If for any reason an adult that is not listed on our system arrives to collect your child, and we have not been informed in advance, we will not release your child to them. To prevent such delays at the end of the school day, we ask that you contact us by 3pm to let us know if you are asking a different adult to collect your child. Please note, any older sibling authorised to collect your child should be aged 14 and over. Your understanding and cooperation in adhering to these procedures is very important. Attendance Matters

Attendance remains a key focus area for the school and has also been reported in the news recently as a key challenge nationally. Last week our overall attendance was 95.34%, just slightly below our target of 96%. A massive EIGHT classes achieved 96+% this week—well done Einstein, Nightingale, Anning, Hawking, Seacole, Parks, Peake and Turing. For the year to date we are at 95.82% and a whopping 292 children had 100% attendance this week. Let's try to be above 96% for the whole school next week ... on time, all day, every day!

Did you know that we have a whole class attendance initiative? When the whole class are in school - and in on time! - they achieve one letter from the word ATTENDANCE. When the word is complete the class gets a non-uniform day. Congratulations to PARKS CLASS who are our latest winners and will wear non-uniform on Monday and well done to Einstein, Nightingale, Attenborough, Seacole and Peake who have all achieve it so far.

Attendance makes such a difference to school success and getting off to a good start to the year and forming those habits early is really important. We have a clear process which is designed to safeguard pupils, families and the school; therefore, you may receive a formal letter from us regarding any absence your child may have. Please support your children to be resilient and come to school every day.

Children's Birthdays

Just to let our new parents know, and a reminder to all our other families, that we do not give out birthday treats of party bags / sweets / cakes to children in the class. In addition to some children having food allergies, parents told us in the past that children were coming home with too many sweets and treats (sometimes 2 to 3 times a week) and asked us to change this. Providing treats for school can be extremely costly and we don't want our families feeling like they have to make this unnecessary expense. Some parents have bought a single book to share with the class and then keep in the class library which is a lovely idea.
