












This week at Cheadle Heath

The closing date for applications for Reception 2024 is January 15th. No need to book, just turn up!

Current Nursery parents: you MUST still apply for a Reception school place. Don't delay, apply today!

A is for Attendance

We are asking for your support in improving whole school attendance and punctuality. The impact upon children's education through lost learning is huge. Following a time when so much education was disrupted it is vital that we make every school minute count. We urge you to ensure that your child is in school and on time every day to prevent anyone falling behind with their learning.

Persistent cases, where poor attendance and punctuality do not improve, can be a safeguarding issue. It is considered that attendance of 90% or below is persistent absence which is closely monitored by school staff and the EWO. Failing to improve attendance can lead to prosecution, which we want to help families avoid. Our whole school attendance target is 96.5%. There are things you can do to improve your child's attendance and avoid falling into the persistent absence category including:

- If your child is unwell and you are unsure whether to send them to school, contact the office to seek advice on 0161 428 2476.
- Avoid taking any holidays during term times. No holidays are authorised and we are advised to refer all those who have taken term time holiday for an EPN (Education Penalty Notice) which results in a fine which is charged per child, per adult. We publish our school holiday dates well in advance, so please refer to these carefully when booking your time away.
- Keep up to date with what % attendance your child has so that you know if they are at risk of persistent absence (Mrs Steele in the office can provide this for you)
- Speak to school staff if you have any concerns about your child

Talk to your child about the importance of them being in school and let them know how important you feel it is. They don't like being late into school and we witness how upsetting it can be for them. We want to prevent this so please remember: on time, all day, every day!

Childcare Choices

Childcare Choices: Get the help that fits your family, so you can juggle work and life. The <u>Childcare Choices website</u> brings together all the existing childcare offers in one place, so parents can get the help that fits their family. This could be through Tax-Free Childcare, 30 Hours Childcare, or Universal Credit Childcare. Some families might be eligible to use more than one childcare scheme together and get the most out of it.
