

#### Safeguarding Corner:

According to a recent Ofcom\* report, 58% of children have had a social media account setup for them by a parent below the age of 11. The top five most popular are YouTube (33%), TikTok (18%), WhatsApp (17%), Snapchat (14%) and Facebook (9%). It's worth noting that on 11<sup>th</sup> April 2024, WhatsApp is reducing their minimum age from 16+ to 13+ but this is still over the age of all our pupils! \*The Ofcom report makes fascinating reading across a number of areas of children's media use.
