Curriculum newsletters are put on class pages just after the new theme is launched rather than in advance as we launch each new theme with an immersive day and keep the surprise. There is a general whole school overview for each year group under the curriculum section but this is only a general theme rather than detailed information. We will have a think about how we could give you more information without giving a spoiler away!
Lots of changes to PE days which is fine but sometimes tricky to keep up with! I don't always get a chance to check dojo every evening or morning but do try to - would it be better to keep a kit at school again?	Yes! We hear what you are saying so, we from September, Reception to Y6 we will be reverting back to bringing PE kits in, keeping them in school and getting changed in school. Coming in PE kits was introduced as a covid measure and saved a lot of time but we recognise that the children are not practising buttons, studs and laces etc. so a change is on its way!
Meetings and events need to cater to working parents more.	We try to hold two meetings after school and later on at 5pm / 5.30pm to cater for working parents and we have the food bank out after school as well as in the day but we cannot cater for all different working patterns and have to be mindful of staff work life balance too. We will commit to reviewing each event in the planning stages and bear this mind next year.
A few things throughout the year have said whole school but this didn't include nursery which is confusing.	Totally our fault! We will be careful and clearer with this next year. Sorry!
Slight drop off homework activities this year e.g. no assignments set on Ed Shed and no checking of reading record.	Ouch! We are REALLY disappointed to hear this so will make sure that this is consistent next year and senior staff will monitor much more carefully.
